William Shakespeare's 1594 great and timeless romantic tragedy is brought to the stage in dance with choreography by Michael Smuin and accompanied by the well-known Sergei Prokofiev music. Set against brilliant costumes and set designs, the choreography incorporates exciting period sword fighting. This presentation provides an excellent opportunity to connect to core-curriculum concepts, and cross curriculum opportunities in reading the play.
